Pentecost 2017

In the run up to Pentecost the Archbishops of Canterbury and York have asked the whole church to pray daily for the church and the evangelisation of England.

Most of us are extremely busy and find it difficult to add anything else to our daily routine, however worthwhile it may be. The following prayers are short. Let us make a corporate decision to use each one on the day appointed, conscious that we are not alone but uniting with others across the parish, regardless of time or place.

Each prayer is related to a psalm. If you are in a position to do so, first read the psalm, then the prayer, perhaps a few words of your own and conclude with the Lord's Prayer.



Monday, 2nd May *Rogation Day* **Psalm 149**

Glorious and redeeming God, give us hearts to praise you all our days and wills to reject the world's deceits, that we may bind the evils of our age and proclaim the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

Psalm 128
O Christ, our true vine,
may we your branches
be ever fruitful in your service
and share your love and peace with all your
children,
in the power of the Spirit and to the glory of
the Father. Amen

Wednesday, 4th May *Rogation Day*

Psalm 15

Lord, lead us to our heavenly home by single steps of self-restraint and deeds of righteousness; through the grace of Jesus Christ our Lord.

Thursday, 5th May **ASCENSION DAY Psalm 8**

We bless you, master of the heavens, for the wonderful order which enfolds this world; grant that your whole creation may find fulfilment in the Son of Man, Jesus Christ our Saviour. **Amen**

Psalm 145
King of the universe,
you show the bright glory of your reign
in acts of mercy and enduring love;
raise the spirits of the downcast
and restore those who have fallen away,
that we may sing for ever of your love;

Saturday, 7th May

Psalm 85

Most holy God,

Monday, 9th May

Psalm 18

From your royal throne, O God, you sent your living Word to pierce the gloom of oppression; so, in our souls' night, come with your saving help and penetrate our darkness with the rays of your glory in Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

Tuesday, 10th May

Psalm 68

Blessed are you, gracious God; you make your home among the weak, you deliver us from death, you bring us joy beyond our imagining to the praise of Jesus Christ our Lord.

Psalm 46
God of Jacob,
when the earth shakes
and the nations are in uproar,
speak, and let the storm be still;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen



Thursday, 12th May

Psalm 139

Creator God,
may every breath we take be for your glory,

that, trusting in your presence in this world,
we may, beyond this life, still be with you where you are alive and reign
for ever and ever. Amen

Psalm 147
Compassionate God,
as you know each star you have created,
so you know the secrets of every heart;

all who are wounded and needy,
that our hungers may be satisfied
in the city of your peace;
through Christ who is our peace. Amen



Saturday, 15th May

Psalm 48

Father of lights, raise us with Christ to your eternal city, that, with kings and nations, we may wait in the midst of your temple and see your glory for ever and ever. Amen

PENTECOST, (Whit Sunday) 15th May

A collect
Holy Spirit, sent by the Father,
